Now celebrating its sixth year, the festival will take place **October 19th to October 22nd** at venues in Mystic, Connecticut and Westerly, Rhode Island. The cornerstone venue is Mystic Luxury Cinemas in Olde Mystic Village. They'll be open with a local premiere and close the festival with an awards event where the best film in each category is recognized.

The screenplay competition, now in its fourth year, is expanding relationships with key partners in the screenwriting industry. The five award winners of the 2023 screenplay competition will be announced at the awards ceremony at **Mystic Luxury Cinemas** on **October 22nd, 2023**.
